NEW UNIT MAKING A BIG DIFFERENCE

The Sheriff's Office kicked off 2025 by introducing its new Community Impact Unit, which in its first several weeks has conducted speed saturations, coordinated an apprehension in St. Paul and assisted with a violent incident in Scandia in a moving vehicle — and, after a traffic stop where the driver fled, arrested a person with active warrants for felony threats of violence, gross misdemeanor domestic assault and felony fleeing police. The countywide patrol unit's leader, WCSO veteran Sgt. Joe Stoehr, explained that CIU combines the Special investigations Unit with the Special Enforcement Team to help bring a more concentrated approach to street-level community concerns like speeding and other traffic safety issues, but also to address complaints ranging from barking dogs to junk houses. "We can be more consistent and come up with more creative solution in addressing things," Sgt. Stoehr said, like working directly with residents and property owners or coordinating discussions between residents and city staff. PERSON IN CRISIS

At 8:55am on Jan. 6, a deputy arrived at a business to speak with a caller about a reported drug house. The caller wasn't dressed for the cold temperature, so they stepped inside the business to talk. The caller then made several seemingly irrational statements, including that there is an unknown drug dealer inside his home and that the dealer was also his wife's mistress. The deputy observed that the caller was disheveled and acting paranoid. Although the caller was initially reluctant to return to the house, the deputy eventually was able to provide him a ride there, as his license was no longer valid due to medical issues. At the home, the deputy spoke to the wife and a son, who both expressed concern over the caller's deteriorating mental health and some fear for their safety due to his behavior when in a paranoid state. EMS arrived and agreed that a mental health hold was necessary. The man was transported to a hospital.
