WAITING FOR WINTER

So far, our winter season has been relatively mild and with very little snow. While it's very unlikely that such luck will last much longer, winter parking restrictions are currently in effect in many of our Washington County communities. Each community is different in its approach, but generally under winter rules, parking is prohibited on designated streets during a certain period, such as from October through May, or during certain times of day or on one side of a roadway.

Washington County deputies are ready to help cities enforce their rules and have already issued citations this season. Last year, from the season that ran November 1, 2021, through May 1, 2022, deputies issued nearly 100 parking citations related to winter parking restrictions.

We encourage each community's leaders to continue to communicate guidelines and restrictions to their citizens so they're prepared and informed this winter!

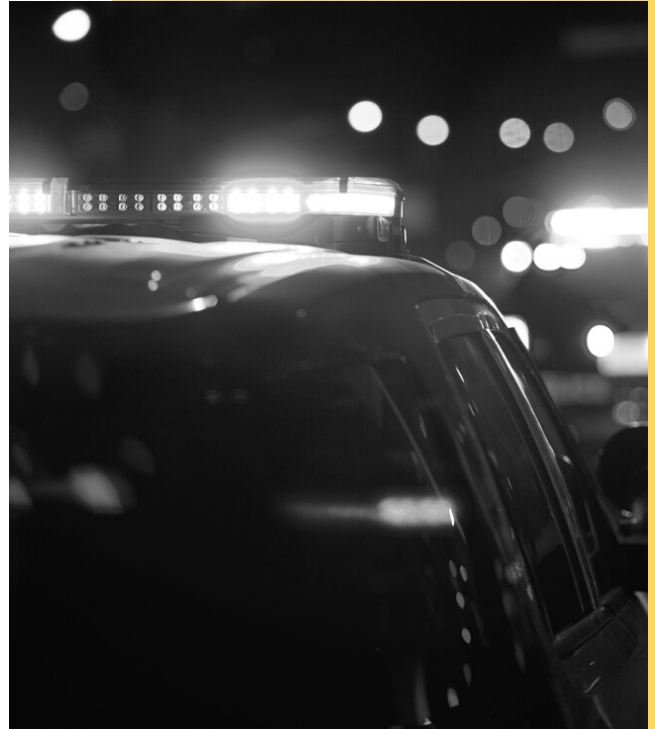

At 7pm on Dec. 12, a deputy arrived at a residence after a report of an ongoing dispute with a neighbor. Most recently, the residents said, the neighbor had removed a netted fence on their side of the property. They also stated that they had received documents that they believed were forged regarding the property line that the neighbor had requested be delivered to them. The deputy took photos of the documents. The residents also said that in the past the neighbor has threatened their dogs and even gone onto their property to attack the dogs, but they didn't have evidence of this. They said they would be getting surveillance cameras for the property, and that they were in the process of getting a harassment restraining order and would be documenting all incidents.
