## BUILDING A WELLNESS PROGRAM

The Washington County Sheriff's Office has launched two in-house programs, one building on another, to support wellness and encourage mental health awareness among all its employees. Check-In from the Neck-Up launched in fall 2023 to provide employees annual one-on-one sessions with Ridgeway and Associates clinicians, who work exclusively with law enforcement.

Growing out of the yearly sessions, the new In-House Clinician Program launched in early May. This program is designed to provide easily accessible, continuous and personalized support for all law enforcement, correctional officers and emergency telecommunicators. These dedicated clinicians will be on-site at the Washington County Government Center for approximately 18 hours a week on a rotating basis, ensuring that support is readily available when it's needed most.

Together, these programs are aimed at building strong, resilient employees, from the day they sign on through the duration of their career by providing training, connecting them with resources, and supporting them throughout their time as part of the team. These programs complement a peer support program, a wellness steering committee, a wellness app, and an in-house therapy dog, all part of the Sheriff's Office commitment to ongoing wellness.

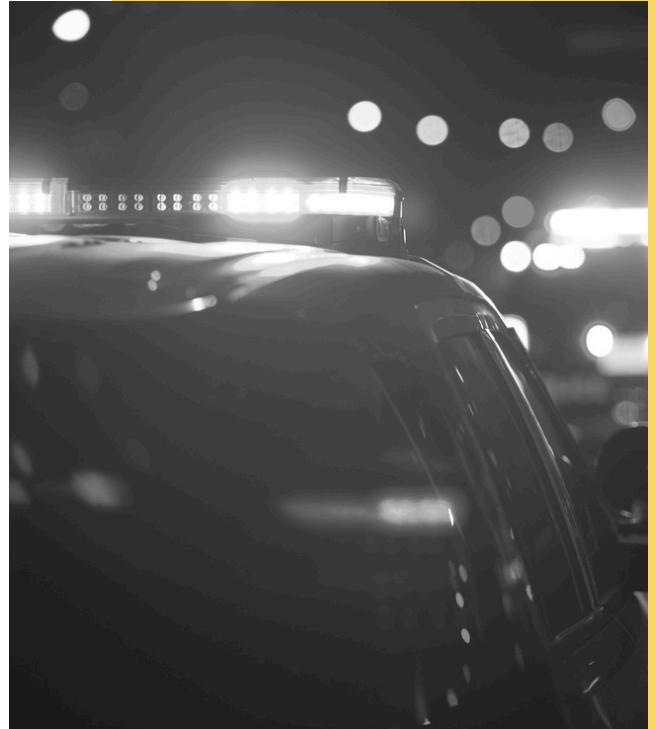

## WATER ACCIDENT

3XX JUDD STREET

At 6:06pm on May 25, deputies responded to a report of a possible drowning on the St. Croix River. While enroute, dispatch advised deputies that CPR was in progress. Upon arrival, deputies were met by the 911 caller, who said their dogs had started barking so they went outside and heard calls for help. The caller saw a person in the water struggling and going past their dock. The caller's husband jumped into the water to try to help the victim and began chest compressions with help from the 911 dispatcher. Unfortunately, despite lifesaving measures by the husband and by first responders, the victim was pronounced dead.
