## REPEAT CHAMPS

Back-to-back champions and setting records in the process: Your WCSO K9 team is the USPCA National Champion for the second consecutive year! Deputy Brandon Yetter and K9 Huck; Deputy Nate Thienes and K9 Goose; Deputy Josh Liebenow and K9 Viking; and Deputy Chris Majeski and K9 Jake traveled to Baton Rouge, La., in October to compete with 67 of the best K9 teams from across the country. They topped them all with the title of 1st Place Department Team. Some details: Deputy Yetter and Huck won 1st Place Overall and back-to-back champions, with a perfect score in suspect search and evidence recovery and 1st place in the combined search score category; Deputy Thienes and Goose took 4th Place Overall; and Deputy Liebenow and Viking took 10th Place Overall. Odin also earned 1st Place in Apprehension and 1st Place in Combined Obedience and Apprehension Score.

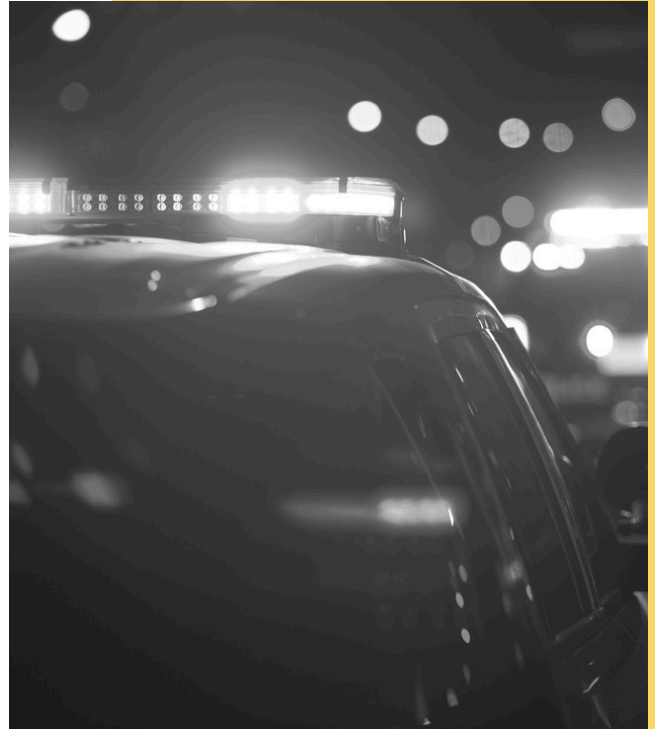

## PERSON IN CRISIS

OSTRUM TRAIL N & OLD MARINE TRAIL N

At 9:53pm on Oct. 19, a deputy responded to a call of a person contemplating suicide who had cut a wrist earlier in the day and had left a note for a roommate. The deputy found the person in their car, where the 911 call had come from. The caller shared recent struggles with the deputy, including that their mental state had declined more rapidly after the recent breakup of a relationship. The deputy advised the caller to talk to professionals at the hospital, which the caller initially resisted. The caller finally agreed to go to the hospital for help. The deputy also provided the number of Washington County Crisis and said they would be reaching out to the caller later.



## MESSAGE FROM THE SHERIFF



Even though winter is fast approaching, we want our communities to know the Sheriff's Office will still be out patrolling on the water — even after it has iced over. And thanks to two federal grants awarded this fall, the Water, Parks and Trails Unit will be able to secure two airboats plus a rapid response patrol boat in our continuing effort to keep our waterways safe.

With 251 lakes in Washington County, the waterways patrolled by the Sheriff's Office vary in both terrain and accessibility. Airboats give rescuers a secure and stable platform to navigate through tricky ice and wetland areas, granting access to remote locations and allowing first responders to safely navigate with enhanced response times and reliability so they can perform essential lifesaving operations.

The Sheriff's Office is the primary law enforcement agency for all county waterways and is part of the area maritime security plan. So a rapid response patrol boat is an important tool to allow our team to provide enhanced security measures and deploy resources quickly and efficiently in the event of an emergency. We're here to protect and serve, no matter the season or the weather.
